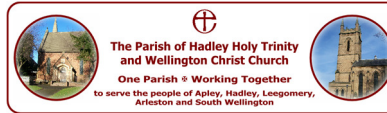

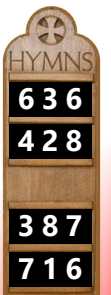
Almighty God,
