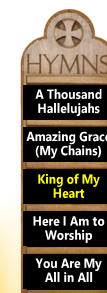

Dried food is particularly helpful because it is less heavy in the van!

Tinned food – potatoes, tomatoes, macaroni cheese, ravioli, meatballs in gravy, minced beef and onion, pasta and sauce, savoury rice, tuna, mackerel, sardines, super noodles.

Cup-a-soup, tea bags, coffee, hot chocolate.

Pasta, rice, breakfast bars, biscuits, chocolates, sweets.

TOILETRIES: Shower gel, toothpaste, tooth brushes, shampoo, shaving soap/foam/razors, deodorant and foot powder.
